



Joe Donovan to Climb Europe's Highest Mountain in aid of Neurofibromatosis Research

At over 18,400 feet, Mount Elbrus towers above its surroundings in Russia's Caucasus Mountains located between the Caspian and Black seas. This gently sloping volcanic peak is the highest point in Europe and renowned as one of the "Seven Summits." From its slopes, high green plains roll eastward into Russia toward the Caspian Sea; to the west is the Black Sea; and to the north are the Caucasus Mountains.
